

Oximetry @Home Pathway for Care Homes

	Care Home Staff	Resident feels unwell and health professional contacted for advice [GP, Hot Hub, OOH, 111) Or resident is tested positive via routine testing Take Baseline Oxygen Saturation
Daily	Registered professional Onboarding to Covid Oximetry @Home	Resident meets inclusion criteria patient should be on boarded. Agrees with Care Home staff that resident should have Oxygen saturation levels monitored Agree review of residents – when and how (e.g. virtually / telephone / face to face
	Care Home Staff	Carer records oxygen saturation 3 times per day (Morning, Afternoon, Evening) and records on diary for 14 days. Carer should have the capacity to accelerate as appropriate as per instructions in Care Home Leaflet
As required	Admin support Monitor up to 14 days	Practice to call Care Home at pre agreed intervals. Confirm O2 sats and assess patient and confirm to care home any other requirements
	Admin support Recovery and Exit	Practice to call patients / carer on day 14 to check progress and discharge if all ok
	Care Home Staff	Decontaminate oximeter Send a copy of the Diary / Recordings of residents oxygen saturations to GP File Diary / Recordings in residents notes
